Raiders sneak by Crest 29-22

Point's Red Raiders had to make a comeback, then hold on at South Point Stadium last night to edge Crest's Chargers 29-22 in a Southwest 3-A Conference headliner that had the fans sitting on the edge of their seats.

Two long-distance runs by Scott Crawford, who went over the 200-point mark for his brilliant Red Raider career, helped turn the tide.

Crawford scored three touch-downs on the night, including two long ones of 60 and 93 yards as the Big Red won their second straight without defeat, and 13th decision in their last 14 games.

Crawford led South Point's steady ground attack, picking up 163 yards in 15 carries. He was aided and abetted by senior quarterback Bill Hannon, who carried five times for 60 yards. The Crest team had an im-

pressive ground attack, led by Bobby Brown and Byron Wray. Brown gained 19 yards in 11 carries while Wray picked up 94 in 11 totes. Crawford, who always excites

the fans with the excitable and sometimes the unexpected, gave

South Point a quick lead. On the first play from scrimmage, Crawford outraced all Crest defenders on a 600-yard scramper which came at the 10:35 mark and gave South Point a 7- lead following Jimmy Stowe's placement.

The lead, however, was short-lived. The Chargers, looking impressive and who will make their mark in the league this year, marched 65 yards in 16 plays, with quarterback Steve Lewis scoring on a rollout from the two with 2:50 remaining in the first quarter. Lewis kicked the extra point, making it 7-7.

A 44-yard kickoff return by Crawford to the Charger 36 set up South Point's second score. Senior fullback Danny Clawson, back in action again, scored from the five but Stowe missed placement leaving from ahead by 13-7.

CREST THEN charged ahead, with a 15-yard penalty following a punt against the Raiders giving Crest a shot at the Raider 32. Barry Adkins later scored from the five at the 6:42 mark, giving Crest a 11-13 lead following the point-after by Lewis.

South Point was pushed back to the three following the kickoff, but two plays later, Crawford raced 93 yards and after Hannon hit Crawford on the two-point conversion, SP held a lead of 21-14 at the half.
