

# Burns eliminates SP

FALLSTON — The Burns bulldogs, stunned 7-0 early in the game on a 53-yard fumble recovery and resulting touchdown run by end Perry Davis of South Point, rallied to defeat the Red Raiders on the Burns field Friday night. 26-20

The loss, South Point's second in a row, eliminated Jim Biggerstaff's team from the SWC playoff running for the first time in five years.

The Raiders fell to 5-3 with the loss and into fourth place in the standings behind Chase, East Rutherford and Shelby.

After Davis' run, Larry Hopper of the Bulldogs took a 50-yard touchdown pass from senior quarterback Steve Gardner and the point-after by Mike Williams tied the game 7-7 early in the second quarter.

Burns took a 20-7 halftime lead on a

29-yard pass from Gardner to Joe Seagle and a 35-yard run by John Vinson.
