Raiders come back to win over RSC

South Point's Red Raiders were forced to come from behind with a 58-yard touchdown drive late in the game at Lineberger Stadium Friday night in order to edge the R-S Central Hilltoppers, 21-14.

The victory was South Point's third in four Southwestern 3-A Conference games. The Raiders used sophomore Randy Richards at quarterback for the game. Perry Fewell scored on a two-yard run with 2:42 remaining in the game, then Jeff Williams ran for the two-point conversion which gave South Point the win. Fewell gained 52 of the yards during the winning

touchdown drive.

Richards passed 44 yards to Rudy Stowe for SP's first touchdown, with Graylyn Faulkenberry converting. Still in the first period, Fewell scored on a four-yard run, giving SP a 13-0 lead. R-S Central came back to take the lead on a one-yard run by Ronald Brown and a 43-yard run by Troy Harris, then a two-point conversion, 14-13. Then came the game-winning drive by the Red Raiders, who gained 205 yards rushing and 57 passing compared to R-S Central's 161 yards rushing and 53 passing.
