

SP blanked, after 69 games

BOILING SPRINGS — Crest's Chargers shut out South Point's Red Raiders here last night, 12-0, in a Southwestern 3-A Conference game. It was the first time South Point had been blanked in 69 straight games, dating back to early in the 1972 season when the Red Raiders and East Gaston battled to a 0-0 tie.

Crest scored with 1:03 remaining in

the first period on a 40-yard drive. Bruce Smith scored on a fourth and seven play on an end-around from 12 yards out.

The touchdown was set up on a pass interception and return by Crest's Cecil Clark from the 47 to the 40.

Crest scored again with 31 seconds remaining in the half on a 30-yard drive following a short 23-yard Raider

punt. The big play was a 27-yard pass on fourth down from Chuck Brown to Quinton Patterson to the Raider 11. Tim Washburn scored on fourth down from the one.

South Point threatened twice. The Raiders moved to the Crest 18 in the third period before being halted. In the third period, SP had first and goal at the Crest six, but was thrown back from the one to the seven.
