

Central 7, South Pt. 0

With forty second left in the game, R.S. Central's David Davis crossed the goal line to give the Hilltoppers a 7-0 victory over the Raiders of South Point. The game was played at R.S. Central.

R.S. Central's last minute touchdown was conceived when a punt by Scott Lee was blocked by Dwayne Martin, with 2:30 left in the game. Martin scrambled to the ball and tried to get a hold, but was unable, so he fell on top of it, setting up the play.

Mackie McKeithan, R.C. Central quarterback, connected a 21-yard pass to Davis, who ran into the end zone for the score.

Neither team showed any real offensive play. South Point ended up with only 111-yards rushing and 49-yards in passing, while R.S. Central out passed the Raiders, with a total of 124, but came out with only 83-yards in rushing.

Both teams are 3-2 for the conference action, and 3-3 over-all.
