South Point routs Trojans in finale

SANDY MUSH-South Point, paced by senior tailback Keith Young's 165 yards rushing in 13 carries and two touchdowns, blanked Chase's Trojans 28-0 here Friday night to conclude its 13th consecutive year in never having had a losing season under head coach Jim Biggerstaff.

The Red Raiders closed out at 5-4 in the Southwestern 3-A Conference and 5-5 overall. Chase finished at 0-9 in the league and 0-10 overall.

The Raiders rolled up 302 yards rushing while holding the Trojans to only 26, and had things pretty much their own way all night, turning back Chase at the South Point 30 in the first half and at the 18 in the second half for the home team's deepest penetrations.

It took South Point only two
plays to move 69 yards for its first
touchdown. Quarterback Scott
Lee dashed 25 yards after a fiveyard penalty against the Trojans,
then Young raced 39 yards for the
score at the 7:16 mark. Lee's two-

point conversion run pushed South Point ahead, 8-0.

South Point moved 65 yards in nine plays with 6:59 remaining in the half, with Lee passing to split end Jerry Howell for six yards and the score. Howell's extra point attempt missed for a 14-0 Raider halftime lead.

Scott Glover's pass interception at the Chase 18 set up South Point's third period touchdown. Junior fullback Preston Earle went in from that point at the 2:03 mark and Howell converted from placement to make it 21-0.

The Raiders moved 62 yards in five plays in the fourth period, with Young scampering 53 yards for the score and Howell again converted at the 9:16 mark.

The passing of Chase quarterback Derrick Dover enabled the Trojans to mount its biggest threat in the fourth period. They picked up four first downs with Dover connecting, moving from the trojan 24 to the South Point 18 for a first down. However, three Dover passes fell incomplete, then he was sacked for 14-yard loss to the Raider 32.
