

# *South Point wins 14-0*

**RUTHERFORDTON** - South Point's Red Raiders, after a scoreless first half, dominated the final two periods of play here Friday night, downing the R-S Central Hilltoppers 14-0 in a Southwestern 3-A Conference game.

Quarterback Mark Young, who gained 141 yards in 12 carries, raced 74 yards at the 9:06 mark and Mike Dudko booted the first of his two extra points.

In the fourth period, with 8:10 remaining, defensive end Jeff Biggerstaff sacked quarterback Tim Kincaid. The ball popped loose, and linebacker Steve Thompson scooped up the loose ball and raced 15 yards for the touchdown.

The Raiders, who had scored only one touchdown all year in the second half until Friday night, completely dominated the second half, moving at will on the ground while holding the Hilltoppers to one first down.

South Point had 300 yards in 54 carries. Thompson picked up 96 yards in 21 carries.

South Point moved to 2-3 in league play and 3-3 overall. R-S Central fell to 1-4 and 1-5.
