

Raiders win

South Point 13

East Rutherford 10

FOREST CITY — Tonja Watson scored from 3 yards out with 1:44 remaining to lift the Red Raiders to the victory in their Southwestern 3-A Conference opener.

Watson's run capped a 58-yard drive that began at the 6:05 mark after the Raiders had recovered an East Rutherford fumble.

The Raiders, who won for the first time in four games while East Rutherford fell to 3-1 overall, trailed 10-7 after B.J. Hamilton kicked a 31-yard field goal in the third period for the Cavaliers.

East Rutherford appeared to have put the game away in the fourth period when Robert Surratt returned a fumbled lateral 50 yards for an apparent touchdown. A clipping penalty brought the play back, however, setting up the fumble and South Point's subsequent winning drive.
