

## West Mecklenburg 26 South Point 6

BELMONT — West Mecklenburg's Indians used bombs instead of arrows here at Lineberger Stadium Friday night, using long scoring strikes in a victory over South Point's Red Raiders.

Larry Thomas took a 54-yard scoring strike from quarterback Derrick McGowan in the opening period, then Luther Holder brooke loose on a 65-yard touchdown jaunt with just two seconds remaining in the first half for a 12-0 halftime lead.

In the third period, the Indians scored two more TDs on a 22-yard run by fullback Ray Hughes and a 62-yard bomb from McGowan to Lawrence Howell.

South Point's lone score came on a 3-yard quarterback keeper by Chris Cornelius in the fourth period. Keith Robbins set up the score with a 34-yard run to the West Meck 9.
