BELMONT — The Cavaliers jumped all over the Red Raiders with three first-quarter touchdowns for the 28-6 Southwestern 3-A Conference football victory.

East Rutherford quarterback Dennis Logan hit T.G. Baker with a 36-yard pass to open the scoring, but it wasn't long before the Cavs were up 21-0.

Maurice Wilkie ran 20-yards for one touchdown, while Rodney Hines went 32 yards for another. East Rutherford improved to 2-0 in the conference and 5-1 overall.

South Point (1-1, 2-4) finally got in the scoring column when Moeo Crawford went over from the 1 in the third quarter. Crawford was held to 92 yards on 18 carries for South Point.

Robert Gray, who scored the final East Rutherford touchdown, totaled 109 yards on 15 carries.
