

South Point upsets Bulldogs

LAWNDALE — South Point took advantage of five pre-holiday gifts from Burns on Friday night, turning fumbles into

points and a 24-0 upset.

The loss ruined what to date had been a perfect Southwestern 3A season for the Bulldogs. The loss was their first in six league games and dropped them to 8-2

overall.

Burns already had clinched at least a share of the league title and a playoff berth.

The Red Raiders, meanwhile, clinched one of three playoff berths awarded the league with the victory, upping their conference mark to 4-1 and their overall record to 6-3. They close at home against Shelby next Friday.

With a victory over the Golden Lions, the Red Raiders would clinch a share of the conference title and earn

the league's No. 1 playoff seed.

Burns laid the ball on the ground six times, losing five. Three of the turnovers led to South Point points — 10 in the second quarter and seven in the fourth. The Red Raiders added a final TD on a 27-yard pass from Courtney Williams to Reggie McLean.
