

# SP rallies in fourth

BELMONT — Trailing 12-0 late in Saturday's Southwestern 3A game against Burns, South Point looked for a miracle.

scoring two fourth-quarter touchdowns and pulling down a game-saving interception at midfield as the Red Raiders won 15-12.

"We looked dead in the water," said South Point coach Phil Tate.

The game was a hard-fought defensive battle with neither team scoring until Quincy Shade broke the ice with a 31-yard run for the Bulldogs with 3:06 left in the third quarter.

Burns padded its lead when defensive end Derrick Cham-

bers recovered a South Point fumble after a high snap from a punt formation with 9:00 left in the game.

The Raiders surprised the Bulldog defense on first down when quarterback Randy Wilkerson hit Tribble for a 68-yard scoring play. SP passed for two points after faking a conversion kick and trailed 12-8.

Burns fumbled the ensuing kickoff and the Raiders had a break. South Point drove to the Burns 1 where the Raiders faced a fourth-and-goal. The Bulldogs stopped Koren Robinson at the goal line.

After gaining yardage to the 17, Burns fumbled it back and Tribble scooped the ball up for the go-ahead score.
