Red Raiders find steam in victory

BELMONT — For a half, South Point High coach John Devine felt his team had been outplayed by winless North Gaston. Even though his team led 31-7.

In the second half, the Red Raiders satisfied their coach while wrapping up a share of the school's 15th conference title in a 65-7 victory.

"I just thought we didn't come out with the intensity they had," Devine said of his team's first-half performance. "Even though the score didn't indicate it, they outplayed us in the first half. And that shouldn't happen—not here (at Lineberger Sadium). In the second half, we gotrolling."

South Point certainly did that, improving their record to 9-1 overall and 5-0 in the Big South 3A/4A Conference. The Red Raiders, who have already wrapped up at least a share of the league title and the No. 1 Class 3A berth, can win its second straight outright league title and increase its conference winning streak to 12 games in next week's regular-season finale at Crest.

"We're guaranteed something already," Devine said.
"And we know (Crest coach)
Roy (Kirby) and them boys are
good. It ought to be a great
Friday night football game."

South Point roared ahead 28-0 before North Gaston tallied its fourth touchdown of the year on Michael Adams' scrambling 19-yard throw to Steven Vernon just before halftime.

Adams was in the midst of his best career game, he completed eight of 18 throws for 123 yards. Markeseo Williams also had a solid effort —with a season's second-best 90 yards in 15 carries.

"I think we hung well with them in the first half," said North Gaston coach Josh Clendenin, whose team finished its season 0-10 overall and 0-6 in the Big South. "I wouldn't go as far as to say we outplayed them. But we played hard and I'm proud ofmy guys."
