

QB Justice cuts up Ashbrook's defense

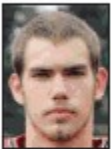
BELMONT — While senior running back Aaron Crumbley was held in check, Josh Justice and company did their part to lead South Point to their seventh-straight win with a 34-0 victory over Ashbrook.

Crumbley, who entered the game averaging 95 rushing yards per game, was held to just 54 yards on 18 carries and one touchdown. Justice

finished with 111 yards and three touchdowns. Justice also connected with Ramon Costner on a 59-yard touchdown pass off of a hook-and-lateral.

"Josh had a great game. They were not going to let Crumbley beat them, but Josh found some cracks," said Red Raiders head coach John Devine. "It was a great win, and a great shutout."

Not to be out done, South Point's defense put on a show of their own. The Red Raiders forced four fumbles, two of which they recovered, and recorded an interception on the way to the shutout. The defense held Ashbrook to just 185

total yards and limited the Green Wave to seven first downs.
"You cannot turn the ball over when you come here. And we just didn't get it done offensively," said Ashbrook's head coach Mike Briggs.
Preston Watts led the way with 117 rushing yards

for the Green Wave (2-6, 1-2 Big South Conference), who will play host to Kings Mountain next week.
South Point (7-1, 3-0 Big South) will look to continue their momentum next week as they travel to Forestview.
