# Big Red Machine getting tuned up

## South Point rushes for 353 yards, routs Lake Norman Charter

#### HUNTERSVILLE

– South Point likes to call themselves The Big Red Machine when things are going good, and everything went well in Friday's 48-0 romp at Lake Norman Charter.

Junior fullback Jake Alexander inched closer to 1,000 yards on the season with 153 yards rushing and four touchdowns on 15 carries in just over half a game.

Junior quarterback Scottie Lee connected on his first three passes for 67 yards and a touchdown, and South Point rushed for 353 total yards. Only one carry resulted in negative yards through four quarters.

"We're getting better," said Red Raiders coach Mickey Lineberger. "We improved from last week, so the best is yet to come."

South Point (5-4, 4-1) received the opening kickoff and moved 66 yards in five plays from scrimmage for the game's first score.

The Raiders scored twice more in the first quarter after Thomas Lempereur tacked on the first of his six PATs, and had a 35-0 cushion at halftime.

Tight end Nick Muse

hauled in a 21-yard TD reception for the first score of the game and senior Max Meadreached paydirt on an 81-yard punt return in the first quarter.

Three of Alexander's scores were in the first half. Recent call-up Naseem Jones had 54 yards on the ground and added a fourth quarter, 2-yard score while running behind the reserves.

"It's good to pitch a shutout," Lineberger said while giving credit to his defense, and also to his unsung QB. "We threw the ball well when we needed to, and we ran the ball. It was a total team effort.

"We've been playing with a chip on our shoulder," he added, noted that his team was still smarting from a home conference loss to Hunter Huss on Sept. 30.

"Our offense is just now starting to click. It took us a little longer than we wanted it to, but we're finally getting where we need to be. It looks pretty good for the playoffs and the rest of the season."

Senior fullback Sean Dugan kept the legs churning after a slow start to gain 35 yards rushing on 10 carries to lead the Knights' offense.

The Red Raiders are back at home next week against rival North Gaston.

Lake Norman Charter (4-5, 0-5), which has been struggling offensively all month, has a road game next week at Ashbrook.
