Warriors: Fast And Experienced

Tonight's Raider opponent, the Warriors, represent East Gaston High School.

East Gaston came into being this year with the consolidation of Mount Holly High and Stanley High.

Both schools fielded outstanding teams last season and with the coming together of the two squads have probably one of the strongest teams the Raiders will face this season.

Head coach of the Warriors is Dick Thompson. Thompson, the coach with the longest tenure of any coach in the county, led the Blue Devils of Stanley to the state 2-A playoffs last year.

Assisting Thompson is Coach Delmar Wiles, who was coach at Mount Holly for 12 years before the two schools consolidated. Wiles' Hawks rang up the best won-lost record in the county over the 12 year period.

The Warrior backfield is fast and seasoned. Boys to watch tonight are Keith Piercy, halfback; Mack Green, quarterback; and Mark Martin, halfback.

Up front the Warriors are led by center Roger Hurst, tackle Mike Williams, guard Terry Pressley, end Richard Smith, and tackle Buddy Bradshaw.

The Warriors got their season underway back on August 25 with a 27-14 win over St. Stephens of Hickory. Last Friday night they went against Glen Alpine.

Next Friday night the Warriors will travel to Morganton to battle Hibriten. Then will take on North Gaston at Dallas on September 29. On October 6 they host East Montgomery at Costner Field in Mount Holly. October 13 will be the Warriors Homecoming, they will battle Bessemer City in a crucial Little Four contest.

Jim Biggerstaff, head football coach and athletic director, has been a red corpuscle of nutrition for South Point High football ... and athletics in general.

Last year in Raiderland, South Point won clear-cut titles in three sports and finished second in two others. Heading the list was the football team, which went 12-0-1 and was WNCHSAA Co-Champs along with Salisbury.

The Red Raider footballers, playoffs included, have won 24 of their last 25 games for the best mark in the entire Association. Biggerstaff's three-year record, starting in 1969, is 26-6-1.

In the rebuilding year of 1969, the Raiders went 5-5 and lost a narrow 14-13 decision in the last minute of play to eventual Association champion Shelby. Among last year's victories was a 26-7 win over Shelby.

Biggerstaff is a Belmont native who played on the unbeaten Belmont team of 1953 that finished 10-1 after a playoff loss to Albemarle. After graduating from Western Carolina, Biggerstaff coached for 10 years at Rockingham before returning to

Belmont, where he was a three-sports standout.

Among Biggerstaff's honors last year was Southwest 3-A Conference Coach-of-the-Year, the North Carolina Coach-of-the-Year by a vote of North Carolina sportscasters, and WBTV sportsman-of-the-week.

Last year's great football record, best in Raider grid history, seemed to spur interest and ambition in other sports. Earl Lingafeldt's girls basketball team won the WNCHSAA title with a glittering 23-1 record.



Lingafeldt is line coach in football while Tate is backfield coach. The new addition to this year's staff is Robert Keaton, who did wonders at Belmont Junior High in all sports and who is end coach. He'll also double up as head boys basketball mentor.

Biggerstaff's club last year scored a whopping 458 points for a 35.2 average and held the opposition to only 88 points for a 6.8 average. In the playoffs, after a perfect 10-0 regular season, South Point roughed up Lincolnton 34-20, Newton-Conover, 41-0, before Salisbury tied them 14-14 in the WNCHSAA title game.

The star of the '71 team was halfback Scott Crawford, who won all the honors, including being named to the All-America He scored 200 points his senior season and was the county and area's leading point producer for two years in a

Others who starred on that team and who graduated included Bill Hannon, Danny Clawson, Dean Ivester, Bill Stone, David Gibson, Mickey Lineberger, Tony Beale, Mike McWhirter, Doug Froneberger and Curtis Moss.

During the 1970 season when the team went 9-1, among those graduated stars were Don Davis, Ronnie Boyles, Randy Stutts, Jerry Conard, Bobby Poole, Randy Walden and Joey Metz, the latter two all-conference tackles.

The '69 team went 5-5 and among those lost by graduation were Burt Broadway, the Breeland Award winner (Crawford won it for two years running), Rick Cherry, Dennis Connell, Jerry Campbell, Tom Knowles, Ronnie Jackson, Bill Ballard, Mark Painter, Lynn Williams and Tommy Armstrong.


