


Ratchford says of Jean, "She is so excellent at her job. In addition to that, she is a very fine lady. She knows about everything concerned with the school.

JIM BIGGERSTAFF

Coach Jim Biggerstaff, head football mentor and athletic director at South Point High School, is in his 13th season at the helm of the Big Red football team.

In those 13 years, Jim had never had a losing record. He is one of the winningest football coaches in North Carolina.

Last year, his South Point team, after having had a fantastic season in 1979, winning the state 3-A championship with a perfect 14-0 record, went into the final two games of the season with a 3-4-1 record.

South Point, proud in football tradition, came back to win the last two games and finish 5-4-1.

Jim, who has coached countless players who have gone on to college stardom, came "back home" to belmont in 1969. He has worked hard to make football THE game in town in the communities which encompass South Point High School.

Biggerstaff's teams play an exciting brand of football out of the Power-I, and the Big Red's swarming defensive units have always been tough on the opposition.

Last year when the Raiders defeated Chase 13-0 at Lineberger Stadium, the victory meant coach Biggerstaff's 100th coaching win at South Point. It was a night he will always remember. He credited his players with a lot of heart for coming back to win the final two games and thus eliminate the possibility of the 1980 team being the first to ever have a losing record at South Point.

Jim has 100 wins to his credit against only 25 losses and six ties. In statistics, that amounts to over eight wins a season--quite a remarkable record.

Biggerstaff, who always gives his assistant coaches and the kids he coaches his thanks for a job well done, is a 1954 graduate of Belmont High School, where he was a star running back on the old Red Raider single wing teams. He was an outstanding baseball player in the spring and a member of the basketball team.

Biggerstaff attended the University of Tennessee during his freshman year in college, playing wingback on the freshman football team. He transferred to Western Carolina University for his sophomore, junior and senior years, playing fullback for the Catamounts.

After graduating from WCU in 1959, Biggerstaff was Bill Eustler's right-hand man for the powerful Rockingham Rockets and the baseball coach there for 10 years prior to returning to Belmont to take over the helm of the Red Raiders in football and to serve as the school's athletic director.

In 1971, Jim was named the outstanding football coach in North Carolina by the Association of Sports Broadcasters. Biggerstaff was the head coach for the West All-Stars in the 1974 East-West game in Greensboro, which was won by the West. He was an assistant coach in the 1975 Shrine Bowl game in Charlotte, which annually pits the top seniors from North Carolina against a similar group from South Carolina.

Jim, a former Belmont Man of the Year, married his high school sweetheart, the former Joyce Wilson of Belmont. They have a daughter, Jamie, who is a junior at Appalachian State University this fall, and a 15-year-old son, Jeff, a sophomore at South Point.



EARL LINGAFELT

Earl Lingafeldt is a 1963 graduate of Drexel High School. He received his BA and BS degree in health and physical education at Lenoir-Rhyne College in 1966.

While at Lenoir-Rhyne, Earl lettered in football as an outstanding lineman for four years and was named to the All-Conference and All-District college teams during his junior and senior seasons.

After graduating from L-R, he came to Belmont as an assistant coach in charge of the line, a position he still holds on the football staff. The Red Raider linemen are aggressive players because Lingafeldt himself was aggressive in the grid sport.

In girl's basketball, where Lingafeldt has been the head coach since 1969, his teams have compiled a winning percentage of over 80 percent and have had great teams in the Southwestern 3-A Conference. In 1977-78 his Raiderettes finished at 26-2, the best record in Raiderette cage annals--dating back to the dirt court high school days in Belmont.

He coached back-to-back WNCHSAA championship girl's basketball teams in '72-'73 and '73-'74. He sent five consecutive teams to the WNCHSAA finals and has coached three All-Staters, Shirle Hart, Beth Beaty and Punkie Mills. Mills, a rising junior at East Tennessee State, is considered a potential college All-American.

Lingafeldt last year coached the boy's basketball team in addition to the girl's team. He coaches the girl's track and field team in the spring. He has been an outstanding slow-pitch softball player for the Carolina A's, the powerhouse team of North Carolina, for several seasons.

Earl and his wife, Mozelle, a Cleveland County native, have two daughters, 7-year-old Lori, a student at Belmont Central, and 2-year-old Leslie.

Phil Tate has always been called "Mister Baseball" in the Southwestern 3-A conference--and the title was never more fitting than last spring when he guided the Red Raiders to the coveted state 3-A baseball championship at Raider Field, beating Eastern Randolph in two straight games in the finals.

The Raiders finished with a 22-5 record. Tate's teams have won six SWC titles in his 12 years at the helm.

Phil is a 1962 graduate of Belmont High School, where he participated in football, basketball and baseball.

He led the Southwestern 3-A Conference in batting as a second baseman for the Red Raiders as a senior with a .384 average.

Tate played baseball at Western Carolina University from 1962-66. He graduated in '67. Tate completed his masters degree at WCU two summers ago.

In football, Phil is the defensive coordinator. He coached the backs at Hunter Huss High School in Gastonia in '67 and '68. He came to South Point in '69, and his SP baseball teams have been practically unbeatable since that time.

In addition to the six SWC titles, the Raiders finished runner-up on two other occaions. His Red Raider Teams won the WNCHSAA championship back-to-back in '72 and '73.

Tate is also a highly successful American Legion coach, having coached Post 144 to the Area Four finals this past summer.

Tate is married to the former Trish Forbes of Belmont and they have two daughters, 11-year-old Kristin and eight-year-old Ashley.

Tate has coached three All-Staters in baseball, Butch Harris, Karl Witzke and (this past spring) Todd Horne.

Butch Adams is a graduate of Ashley High School and Wofford College where he lettered four years in baseball.

After graduating from Wofford, Adams taught for two years at Humphrey School in Lowell. He took a coaching position at Holbrook Junior High in 1970, coaching both football and baseball.

Adams is beginning his fourth full year at South Point, where his is an assistant coach in football and varsity boy's track and field mentor. His 1977 and 1978 Red Raider track and field teams captured the Gaston County Track Meet and the Southwest Conference Championship. His 1978 track and field team finished third in the state meet in Raleigh after winning the regional title.

After only three years at South Point, Adams has developed a deep pride in the overall program of the school. "Coaching at South Point has been a most enjoyable experience," said Adams, a former standout softball player on major slow-pitch softball

Adams and his wife, Vicki, and eight-year-old son Jason live in Gastonia.



Dr. Shaver makes the annual presentation himself, and with his witty style is always a big hit during the brief time he is in front of the microphone.




