David's many contributions to our organization will be remembered for years to come because he has worn so many hats and done so many different things for the Club and the children. His favorite saying is

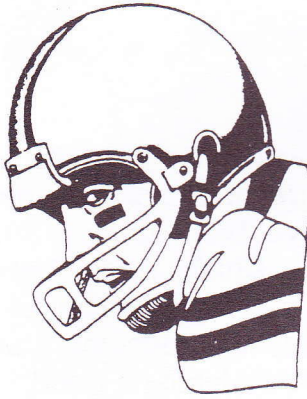
**"The bottom line is — we want the best for our athletes."**
