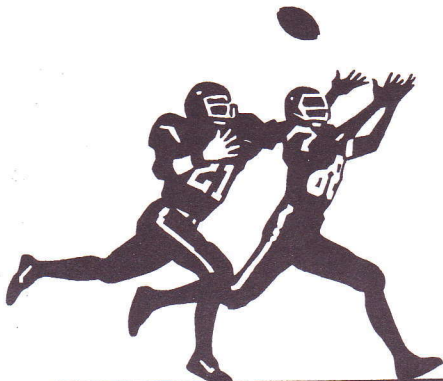

School History and Characteristics

South Point High School is a public suburban high school of grades 9-12. The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools has accredited the school since 1974. The birth of South Point High School required a transitional period of 6 years. The 27 acres of land was purchased in 1962. In 1963, the first plans were designed for a 2-wing facility. In September of 1964, 748 students and 30 teachers returned to "Belmont High School" in its new location: the cafeteria was completed in November. The new school brought new opportunities for the students such as mechanical drawing, art, chorus, school yearbook/ newspaper, and distributive education. In 1969, Cramerton High School consolidated with Belmont High School to form its present name of South Point High School. Enrollment increased to 900 students. In 1997, Gaston County made the transition from Junior High to Middle School; the 9th graders increased enrollment to 1100 students. New additions were made to the school in 1995 and 1999. The latest improvements have been new stadium ticket booths, additional fencing, and a distance learning lab. Today our campus records indicate 33.7 acres and 156,485 square footage.

The school day begins at 7:55am and ends at 2:55pm. We operate on a block schedule of 4 periods. Third period is extended for four lunch sessions. A cafeteria staff of 13 provides hot and cold breakfast and lunch each day. Two semesters make up the school year, with 18 weeks in each semester with a total of 180 days. Gaston County Schools provides bus transportation to and from our school totaling 7 buses. Nearly 600 students are transported from our school hub; 250 of which are South Point students. The majority of our students drive alone or carpool.

South Point is continually striving to ensure a safe learning environment for its students and faculty. A Safe School Plan is in place and includes the following procedures: bomb threats, tornado and fire evacuations, lockdowns, sweep team, and first responders. Staff and faculty training is held several times each year for safety and violence prevention.

South Point's faculty consist of 62 instructional teachers, 4 administrators (one principal and 3 assistants), and 46 support personnel who includes bus drivers, cafeteria workers, a career development coordinator, custodians, guidance counselors, media specialists, a school nurse, office assistants/secretary, security personnel, a social worker, teacher assistants and a distance learning technician. 75% of administration and 53% of instructional staff have 10 or more years of experience in education. A strong characteristic is that 37% of our instructional personnel have advanced degrees. Faculty and Staff are very involved with the operation of South Point. Each department is represented by a department chair. Faculty and staff serve on 15 committees and provide supervision for after-school events on and off campus.

South Point offers many extra curricular activities to its students, many of which support the curriculum. These include Model UN, Moot Court, DECA, Environmental Club, Hi-Q Team, Pep Club, Spanish Club, FBLA, ROTC Drill, Beta Club, Student Council, HOSA, Junior Heart Board, FCCLA, French club, National French Honor Society, Bible Club, FTA, Drama Club, FCA, Interact Club, SAVE and the National Vocational Honor Society. In addition, SPS offers 13 sports on both the junior varsity or varsity levels.

School Awards and Honors

- **80 to 85% of SP's graduates go on to schools of higher education.**
- **Over 1.5 million dollars in scholarship money is awarded to SP's graduates each year.**
- **Two young men from South Point (twin brothers) were selected to attend the North Carolina High School Honors Chorus. Over 1,000 students auditioned and only 200 were selected.**
- **"The Clarion" SP's yearbook, won the prestigious All-North Carolina Award by the NC Scholastic Media Association in addition to awards for cover design, theme and photography two consecutive years 2003 and 2004.**
- **Varsity Football team won 3-A State Championship 2003 and have been Conference Championships 6 years in a row from 1999 - 2004.**
- **The Red Raiders also won Big South 3-A Conference Championships in Swimming and Women's Golf in 2004-2005.**
- **The Lady Raiders Swim Team finished fourth in the State in 2005. With 69 schools competing, this was a tremendous effort on the part of our swimmers.**
- **JNROTC received 5 trophies at the Patriot Classic Drill meet and was named Over-All Champion against 26 other teams in the meet.**
- **The Red Raider Band received numerous first and second place awards as well as, superior ratings in Music, Percussion, Color Guard, and Drum Major in 2004 continuing a 25 year record of superior music for the school. The band was also selected as the honor band for The Carolinas' Carrousel Parade 2005. 18 students were chosen for All-County Band, 4 were named to the All-District Band, 2 were chosen for the Charlotte Wind Ensemble, and 1 student was chosen to participate this summer in the award winning Carolina Crown Drum Corp International.**
- **The Choral classes had more superior ratings at the 2005 District Choral Festival than any other school in Gaston County. They had 4 Superior ratings and 1 Excellent.**
- **Two of SP's finest young men were selected to play on the 2004 Shrine Bowl team.**
- **SP's Carrousel Princess 2004 was crowned Carolinas' Carrousel Queen 2004**
- **Two students gave outstanding speeches at round two of the Optimist Club Oratorical Contest. One student won first prize and will now proceed to round three as a semi-finalist.**
- **687 students hold valid Renaissance Cards in the spring of 2005! A new school record!**
