### **Facts about South Point Student Athletes**

Did you know?

- Every varsity athletic team for the 2010-11 had a 3.0 or better unweighted GPA.
- 19 out of 20 varsity athletic teams were named Scholar Athlete teams by the NCHSAA for maintaining an unweighted 3.1 or above GPA.
- We had 246 student-athletes. Of that number 188 or 76% were NCHSAA Scholar Athletes, maintaining a 3.5 or above weighted GPA.
- The South Point women's golf team was named the NCHSAA State Scholar Athlete team for that sport by having the highest GPA of any women's golf team in the state.
