Facts about South Point Student Athletes

Did you know?

- 18 out of 20 varsity athletic teams were named Scholar Athlete teams by the NCHSAA for maintaining an unweighted 3.1 or above GPA.
- We had 289 student-athletes. Of that number 203 were NCHSAA Scholar Athletes, maintaining a 3.5 or above weighted GPA.
- For the second year in a row the South Point women's golf team was named the NCHSAA State Scholar Athlete team for that sport by having the highest GPA of any women's golf team in the state.
- 53 South Point students participated in at least one varsity sport during their senior year. These senior athletes earned \$515,056 in athletic scholarship money
earned \$1,486,284 in academic scholarship money
earned \$2,001,340 in total scholarship money.
- 90% of athletes from the Class of 2012 will be attending a 4 year college/university this fall.
- 96% of the athletes from the Class of 2012 will be continuing their education in some way (college, community college, or trade school).
- All 3 Chief Junior Marshals and 8 out of 12 junior marshals were student athletes.
- Last year's valedictorian and salutatorian were both student athletes.
- Last year's Student Body President, Student Body Secretary/Treasurer, Senior Class President, and Junior Class President were student athletes. Two-thirds of all class officers were student athletes.
- South Point has begun another academic recognition for its athletes – the South Point Academic All Conference Red Raider Team. There will be a fall sports team and a winter/spring sports team. We had 12 members on the fall team and 10 members on the winter/spring team. These athletes must be named an All Conference Player, have a 3.5 unweighted GPA during that sport semester, have no infractions, and a maximum 5 excused absences. Their names will be framed and hung in the gym lobby.
