FACTS ABOUT SOUTH POINT STUDENT ATHLETES - 2013-14

DID YOU KNOW?

- * 15 out of 20 varsity athletic teams were named Scholar Athlete teams by the NCHSAA for maintaining an unweighted 3.1 or above GPA. One team, ladies golf, had a 3.562 GPA, but, having only 4 members, did not meet the minimum requirement of 5 members required by the NCHSAA to be recognized as a team.
- * We had 262 student athletes. Of that number 211 were NCHSAA Scholar Athletes, maintaining a 3.5 or above weighted GPA.
- * 46 of our athletes were Scholar Athletes in 2 different seasons.
- ·* For the second year in a row the South Point men 's cross country team was named the NCHSAA State Scholar Athlete Team for that sport by having the highest GPA of any men's cross country team who reported their GPA in the state.
- * South Point's athletic teams had a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.384.
- * 71 South Point students participated in at least one varsity sport during their senior year. Of these senior athletes 93% will be continuing their education in some way (college, university, community college, or trade school).
- * The Chief Junior Marshal and 6 out of 12 junior marshals were student athletes.
- * The Co-Valedictorians and Co-Salutatorians of the Class of 2014 were Scholar Athletes.
- * Quinn Barnette, a member of the cross country and swim teams, was the recipient of the esteemed Levine Scholarship to UNCC and was also named a Time Warner Cable NC Scholar Athlete of the week.
- * Katie Scruggs, a member of the cross country and swim teams, was a recipient of the prestigious Park Scholarship to NC State.
- * South Point has begun another academic recognition for its athletes the South Point Academic All Conference Red Raider Team. There is a fall sports team and a winter/spring sports team. We had 6 members on the fall team and 16 members on the winter/spring team. These athletes must be named an All Conference Player, have a 3.5 unweighted GPA during that sport semester, have no infractions, and a maximum 5 excused absences.
- * Members of the fall Academic All Conference Red Raider team are Madison Carr, Chelsea Houser, Morgan Mahaffey, Madison Monteith, Jenna Rayfield, and Grace Russell. They were recognized at the spring sports awards banquet.
- * Members of the winter/spring sports Academic All conference Red Raider team are Michael Auten, Brittany Franks, Sierra Ghorley, Rachel Henninger, Kayla Karr, Sam Killen, Morgan Mahaffey, Allison Moody, Max Neisler, Breanna Powell, Jenna Rayfield, Katie Scruggs, Nick Stafford, Haley Stockton, Phillip Telsrow and Aurora Zeimer. They will be recognized before the August 29th football game.


